In 1990, Matt and Heather wished to ride in a big rig. An abundance of truck drivers wanted to be involved so our volunteers thought that additional wish children should be invited to enjoy the adventure. Forty-three trucks later Matt and Heather's wish came true and our convoy was born! In 2003 the convoy set the Guinness World Record for the Worlds Longest Truck Convoy. In 2004, we broke our own record with 391 trucks.

Today 350-450 trucks come together each year to support the foundation. For many it is a tradition. For others it's a passion. Carrying the most precious cargo of all—our wish kids—most drivers form a bond with the children that lasts a lifetime.



The drivers are a main factor in the success of this event. Each driver is asked to collect pledges. The 30 drivers who raise the most money are awarded the distinct honor of being placed in our front row. The competition is quite stiff.
